Scholarships to study at the University of Ghent (Belgium) in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA1

Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility for study offers the possibility to spend a period of studies at the **University of Ghent** for **Bachelor and PhD students** from the University of Sfax

Mobility students will be awarded a scholarship, will attend courses and will use all the facilities of the University of Ghent on an equal basis as the enrolled students.

All passed exams previously approved in the **Learning Agreement**, will be recognised by the home institution (University of Sfax).

- Enrollment in degree course
- Copy of the Passport
- Knowledge of English (B2- Certificate if available)
- Transcript of Records
- Short CV



- Motivation letter or short version of the research proposal in case of doctorate students (signed by the PhD student and the academic tutor)
